Thank you for your interest in this call for proposals. The European Commission has now finalized the evaluation of applications which were submitted within the framework of the call for proposals EAC 17/07: "Organisation and implementation of an annual EU-Prize for literature".

According to the provisions of the call, the proposals have been evaluated by an internal committee of the European Commission. The evaluation committee examined 8 applications.

I regret to inform you that further to the examination of the proposals, the European Commission has come to the conclusion that none of the offers provides a sufficiently convincing guarantee that the Prize would be implemented in line with the objectives identified by the Commission.

Given this outcome, the European Commission has decided not to award a grant for this call for proposals. It will publish a new call in 2008 taking into account the experience drawn from this call.
