Program:

26 February: arriving and dinner

27 and 28 February: workshop

01 March: breakfast and leaving the venue

During the workshops, participants had the chance to learn more about:

- gender equality,
- gender stereotypes and
- how these manifest in online spaces,
- Reflect on their own experiences as targets, objects or witnesses of gendered disinformation and misinformation.

Because of their age and risks to be alone in the night hours in the streets of the unknown town, after dinner we've organized a special sessions:

- 27 February, for evening session: meeting with **practitioners**: fact-checkers, influencer and expert digital security about critical thinking and how to check the information;
- 28 February: **movie screening** and discussions with representatives from The National Commission for Combating Trafficking in Human Beings with a **topic of human traffic and exploitation** and new approaches of Traficants

Participants had the opportunity to share with their peers, emotions, thoughts, fears and concerns and explore solutions or prevention measures to address the problem.

In the end, each participant received a Certificate.
